1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1718-H** is enacted to read:

3 **§1718-H. Posting of costs by hospital**

4 A hospital licensed pursuant to chapter 405 shall post on its publicly accessible website  
5 the cost to a patient of procedures, services, medications and equipment provided by that  
6 hospital. A hospital shall provide notice to a patient of this posting and shall provide these  
7 costs to a patient upon the request of that patient. Notwithstanding Title 17-A, section  
8 1705, a violation of this section is a Class E crime for which a fine of \$1,000 per day may  
9 be adjudged.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill requires a hospital to post on its publicly accessible website the cost to a  
12 patient of procedures, services, medications and equipment provided by that hospital. It  
13 requires a hospital to provide notice to a patient of this posting and provide these costs to a  
14 patient upon the request of that patient. A violation of the provisions of the bill is a Class  
15 E crime for which a fine of \$1,000 per day may be adjudged.
