1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §654-A, sub-§1, as amended by PL 2019, c. 401, Pt. A, §8, is
 further amended to read:

Exemption. The For property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2021, 10%
 of the just value of residential real estate up to the just value of \$4,000, having a taxable
 situs in the place of residence, of inhabitants of the State who are legally blind as
 determined by a properly licensed Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Osteopathy or Doctor of
 Optometry is exempt from taxation.
