 20 Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1583-A, or any other
 21 provision of law, those limited-period positions recommended for continuation in
 22 Legislative Document 1509, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for
 23 the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds and Changing
 24 Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government
 25 for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2015" of the 126th Legislature
 26 may continue to be occupied through June 30, 2013.
