# An Act to Support Farmland Conservation

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

#### Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §164, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

- **5. Funding.** A separate nonlapsing, interest-bearing account, administered by the department, is established in the department within the Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to support public-private partnerships to carry out the purposes of the program. The account consists of money appropriated or allocated to it by the Legislature or received from any private or public source.
- **Sec. 2. Transfer.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before June 30, 2026, the State Controller shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Maine Working Farmland Access and Protection Program established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 164 for funding to support farmland conservation efforts.
- **Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

14 SUMMARY

 This bill establishes a separate nonlapsing, interest-bearing account administered by the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to support public-private partnerships to carry out the purposes of the Maine Working Farmland Access and Protection Program. The account consists of money appropriated or allocated to the program account by the Legislature or received from any private or public source.

The bill establishes and provides ongoing funding for one full-time, permanent position within the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources.

The bill also transfers \$1,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to fund farmland conservation efforts under the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Maine Working Farmland Access and Protection Program.
