1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3910-B, sub-§1-A**, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 539, Pt. CCCC,  
3 §2, is amended to read:

4 **1-A. ~~Option to contract for administration~~ Administration of the fund.** The  
5 commissioner ~~may~~ shall contract the administration of the fund to a suitable organization  
6 or individual selected through a competitive process. The contracting organization or  
7 individual shall administer the fund in accordance with procedures and eligibility standards  
8 established under subsection 2. The contracting organization or individual may not expend  
9 more than 15% of the fund annually for administrative costs.

10 **Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §3910-B, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 539, Pt. CCCC, §3,  
11 is amended to read:

12 **4. Oversight.** The Animal Welfare Advisory Council established in section 3906-C  
13 or a subcommittee of the council shall review the objectives of the fund and make  
14 recommendations for maximizing use of available resources to meet the objectives of the  
15 fund. The council or subcommittee shall review the administration of the fund and make  
16 recommendations, ~~which may include~~ including the development of a competitive process  
17 to contract for the administration of the fund.

18 **SUMMARY**

19 This bill requires the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to  
20 contract for the administration of the Companion Animal Sterilization Fund.
