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SUMMARY

22 This bill, which is a recommendation of the Commission To Study Difficult-to-place
23 Patients, establishes an additional Nurse Education Consultant position within the
24 Department of Health and Human Services.

25 The committee has not taken a position on the substance of the plan or this bill and by
26 reporting this bill out, the committee is not suggesting and does not intend to suggest that
27 it agrees or disagrees with any aspect of this bill. The committee is reporting the bill out
28 for the sole purpose of turning the commission's proposal into a printed bill that can be
29 referred to the committee for an appropriate public hearing and subsequent processing in
30 the normal course. The committee is taking this action to ensure clarity and transparency
31 in the legislative review of the proposal.
