An Act to Allow Student Representation Within the Governance of the University of Maine System

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, first \P , as amended by PL 1985, c. 779, §89, is further amended to read:
Sec. 4. Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall consist consists of 16 25 members.
Sec. 2. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 735, §73, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
3. Student members. Ten of the members must be full-time students of the University of Maine System. The student members, one from each of the student bodies of the University of Maine Graduate School, the University of Maine, the University of Maine at Augusta, the University of Maine at Farmington, the University of Maine at Fort Kent, the University of Maine at Machias, the University of Maine at Presque Isle, the University of Southern Maine Graduate School, the University of Southern Maine and the University of Maine School of Law, must be elected by their student bodies or selected by their student governments. The student members are full voting members of the board of trustees and shall serve for 2-year terms and until successors are qualified.
SUMMARY This bill replaces the current student member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System with 10 student representatives to the board, as elected by their student bodies or selected by their student governments, who serve as full voting members of the board, with all the rights of other appointed members but with 2-year terms.
