1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-O** is enacted to read:

3 **§150-O. Maine Childhood Cancer Awareness Month**

4 The month of March of each year is designated as Maine Childhood Cancer
5 Awareness Month, and the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and
6 urging the people of the State to observe the month through appropriate activities and to
7 become informed about childhood cancer.
