15	Sec. BBBB-1. 22 MRSA §1708-A is enacted to read:		
16	<u>§1708-A. Per diem payments to Maine Veterans' Homes</u>		
17 18 19 20	Services provided by a veterans' facility must be reimbursed by the MaineCare program at rates established by the department in accordance with this section. This section applies to rates that are paid from all funds, including federal funds, by an agency of the State to a veterans' facility for resident care.		
21 22	<b><u>1. Definitions.</u></b> As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.		
23 24	A. "Multilevel health care facility" has the same meaning as in section 7852, subsection 10-A.		
25	B. "Nursing home" has the same meaning as in section 1812-A.		
26	C. "Residential care facility" has the same meaning as in section 7852, subsection 14.		
27 28 29	D. "Veterans' facility" means a nursing home, residential care facility or multilevel health care facility that is operated by the Maine Veterans' Homes at any location required under Title 37-B, section 601, subsection 2.		
30 31	<b>2. Per resident basis.</b> Veterans' facilities must be reimbursed on a per resident daily rate basis for services to residents covered by the MaineCare program.		
32 33	<b>3. Rate calculations.</b> Different rates must be established for nursing home services and residential care facility services provided by a veterans' facility.		
34 35	A. For nursing homes, rate calculations under this section must follow the process and principles established in section 3173-J to determine a daily rate that is reasonable and		

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1adequate to cover the MaineCare allowable costs of operating a nursing home operated2by the Maine Veterans' Homes to reflect any meaningful cost differences between3veterans' and nonveterans' nursing home costs for the direct care and routine care cost4components of the daily rate. Adjustments to rates and reimbursement for purposes5that include, but are not limited to, audit procedures, quality and case mix must be made6in the same manner as those adjustments are made for all other nursing homes as7established in department rule.

8 B. For residential care facilities, rate calculations under this section must include an 9 add-on per diem rate that is reasonable and adequate to cover the demonstrated 10 MaineCare allowable costs of operating veterans' facilities that are residential care 11 facilities when provided in addition to the per diem rates already established under 12 MaineCare rules for reimbursement of residential care facilities. The add-on amounts 13 are subject to cost settlement so that total reimbursement does not exceed MaineCare 14 allowable costs for each facility.

4. Annual adjustments for inflation. The per diem rates must be annually adjusted
for inflation to the same extent that MaineCare reimbursement rates for other nursing
homes and residential care facilities that are not operated by the Maine Veterans' Homes
are adjusted.

19 Sec. BBBB-2. Supplemental payments previously appropriated. Upon 20 implementation of the rate calculations process established in the Maine Revised Statutes, 21 Title 22, section 1708-A, any supplemental funding allocated or appropriated for the Maine 22 Veterans' Homes in Public Law 2023, chapter 412 that has not been expended may not be 23 used as supplemental payments but may be used for the purposes of this Part.
