COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 76, L.D. 108, Bill, “An Act To Allow a Law Enforcement Agency That Treats a Person with Naloxone Hydrochloride To Bill That Person for That Treatment”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3-A in the 5th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "provided" the following: 'or the legal guardian of that person'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, clarifies that the legal guardian of a person who receives naloxone hydrochloride may be billed for the cost.
