SUMMARY

5 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, strikes language in the 6 bill authorizing a pharmacist to use a standing order to facilitate billing for a 7 nonprescription oral hormonal contraceptive or nonprescription emergency contraceptive 8 and clarifies that enrollees must purchase contraceptives at the pharmacy counter in order 9 to be reimbursed by a health insurance carrier for an out-of-pocket payment. The 10 amendment also removes from the bill the requirement that the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance submit a report to the Legislature but retains 11 12 language requiring the bureau to monitor compliance with the bill's requirements on an 13 ongoing basis.
