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1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment adds to the study commission created in the bill 2 members of the
3	judicial branch, appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court. The
4	amendment clarifies that the commission must consider how to make foreclosed property
5	available for sale in appropriate circumstances. Finally, the amendment directs the
6	commission to submit a report to both the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and
7	Economic Development and the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary and authorizes
8	each committee to report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 132nd
9	Legislature.
