COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 194, L.D. 296, “An Act to Ensure Municipalities Receive a Higher Percentage of All-terrain Vehicle Registration Fees to Cover Increased Expenses”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Ensure Municipalities Receive a Higher Percentage of All-terrain Vehicle and Snowmobile Registration Fees to Cover Increased Expenses'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13105, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

B. Agents may charge a service fee of not more than ~~\$1~~ \$5 for each snowmobile ~~registration or renewal registration issued and \$2 for each registration~~ covered by sections 13002 to 13005. This service fee is retained by the agent.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §13156, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

3. Service fees. An agent may charge a service fee of ~~\$1~~ not more than \$5 for each ATV ~~registration or renewal registration issued and \$2 for each registration~~ covered by sections 13002 to 13005. This service fee is retained by the agent.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. The amendment increases the service fee an agent may charge for issuing a registration or renewal registration for a snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle to not more than \$5.
