COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 247, L.D. 342, Bill, “An Act To Waive Driver's License and Nondriver Identification Card Fees for Current and Recently Discharged Members of the Armed Forces”

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~30 days~~ 2 years" and inserting the following: '30 180 days'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the amount of time within which a person released or discharged from the United State Armed Forces may obtain a driver's license or nondriver identification card without paying a fee from 2 years as proposed in the bill to 180 days.
