14 15	Whereas, farmers and food producers are facing increasing challenges when trying to access both state and federal grant programs; and
16 17 18 19	Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period to allow the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to study the bureau's financial assistance programs to identify barriers to and improve effectiveness of these programs as soon as possible; and
20 21 22 23	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'
24	Amend the resolve by adding before the summary the following:
25 26	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
27 28	Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
29	SUMMARY
30	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the resolve.
