26 27 28	3. It removes from the bill the allowance for Efficiency Maine Trust funds for conservation programs that help reduce energy costs for electricity consumers to be used toward the achievement of the weatherization goals described in the bill.		
29 30 31	4. It includes a General Fund appropriation of \$25,000,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 to the Heating Fuels Efficiency and Weatherization Fund within the Efficiency Maine Trust to support the weatherization of homes and businesses.
