COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 428, L.D. 660, “An Act to Provide Transparency and Public Access to Public School Curricula”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4710-D in subsection 7 in the first 2 lines (page 2, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "to act as the single source for all student information and data"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
