Report. Resolved: That, by June 30, 2026, the Maine State Housing 16 Authority shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and Economic 17 Development with details on the authority's pilot project to facilitate rent payment history 18 19 reporting to credit reporting agencies for purposes of establishing or improving the credit 20 ratings of low-income residential tenants through voluntary participation of residential 21 landlords and tenants in the State in submitting rent payment histories of tenants. The report 22 must include details on the effectiveness of collecting and reporting rent payment histories, 23 an analysis of any improvement in the credit ratings of tenant participants and 24 recommended legislation to make the pilot project permanent. The joint standing 25 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over housing and economic development 26 matters may report out legislation based upon the report to the 133rd Legislature in 2027.' 27 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 28 number to read consecutively. 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This amendment replaces the bill, which is a concept draft, with a resolve. It requires 31 the Maine State Housing Authority to submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on 32 Housing and Economic Development, by June 30, 2026, about its pilot project to collect 33 and report tenant rent payment histories to appropriate credit reporting agencies with the 34 purpose of improving the credit ratings of low-income residential tenants.
