20 21	B. The fee for an initial license or a license renewal under section 18342 or a permit under section 18379 may not exceed \$1,000; and

27 28 29 30 31	This amendment replaces the bill and clarifies the maximum licensing fees for dental providers. The amendment provides that the maximum fee for an initial license or a license renewal for a dentist and for a sedation permit is \$1,000 and that the maximum fee for an initial license or a license renewal for a dental hygienist is \$200; otherwise the maximum fee of \$550 for any one purpose under current law continues to apply.
