COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 530, L.D. 750, Bill, “An Act To Provide \$500,000 of Matching Funds over 4 Years through Appropriations and Allocations To Preserve Rural Heritage and Living History Pertaining to Science and Technology in Penobscot and York Counties”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide \$250,000 of Matching Funds over 2 Years through Appropriations and Allocations To Preserve Rural Heritage and Living History Pertaining to Science and Technology in Penobscot and York Counties'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Historic Preservation Commission 0036

Initiative: Provides a total of \$250,000 over 2 years to assist the Curran Homestead Village and Willowbrook Village museums in consolidating historical collections. The grant must be matched by local funds.
