COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 558, L.D. 824, Bill, “An Act Regarding Ethanol Motor Fuel”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1457, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Ethanol-free motor fuel. A motor fuel distributor, franchisor or refiner may not impose any condition, restriction, agreement or understanding that prohibits or limits the sale, resale, transfer or purchase of conventional, ethanol-free motor fuel products in the State.'

SUMMARY

This amendment makes a change to a headnote and removes language that makes the statutory provision of the bill apply notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary. It also removes the requirement in the bill that directs the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to convene a stakeholder group to conduct a study regarding motor fuel and fuel additives.
