2	This amendment changes the fine structure proposed in the bill from a \$2,500 fine for	
3	each subsequent violation of the various wage and hour laws to a fine of at least \$500 but	
4	not more than \$2,500 for each subsequent violation. It also strikes new language added	
5	by the bill regarding a civil action remedy for violations of various wage and hour laws.	
6	It reduces the liquidated damages available in a civil action to collect unpaid minimum	
7	wages from 3 times the amount of unpaid wages, as proposed by the bill, to twice the	
8	amount of unpaid wages, and it reduces the Labor and Safety Inspector positions added to	
9	the bill from 10 to 4.
