Gould School pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 3815 and who are preparing to graduate 20 21 pursuant to the department's rule Chapter 127: Instructional Program, Assessment and 22 Diploma Requirements. The distribution model must include distributing the guidance to 23 all superintendents, principals and school counselors and to the principal of the Arthur R. 24 Gould School and yearly notice of the guidance and must include, but not be limited to, the 25 following diploma options for the student: an Arthur R. Gould School diploma, a diploma from the student's sending school or a Department of Education diploma under Title 20-A, 26 27 section 257-A.' 28 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 29 30 **SUMMARY** 31 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the Department of 32 Education to create and distribute guidance for superintendents, principals, school 33 counselors and the principal of the Arthur R. Gould School to inform them of diploma 34 options for residents of the Long Creek Youth Development Center who are attending the
