COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 692, L.D. 1063, “An Act to Require Competitive Procurement of Electricity from Generators Fueled by Municipal Solid Waste in Conjunction with Recycling”

Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3210, sub-§3, ¶A,** as amended by PL 2023, c. 361, §1, is further amended to read:

A. For the purposes of meeting the portfolio requirement under this subsection, a 300% multiplier is applied to the output of a generator fueled by municipal solid waste in conjunction with recycling that has obtained a solid waste facility license from the Department of Environmental Protection.

This paragraph is repealed January 1, ~~2027~~ 2026.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §3210-K in subsection 1 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "pays state excise, income, property and sales taxes" and inserting the following: 'is licensed by the Department of Environmental Protection as a solid waste facility in accordance with Title 38, section 1310-N'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the repeal date applicable to the law that applies a 300% multiplier to the output of a generator fueled by municipal solid waste in conjunction with recycling for the purposes of the Class II resource portfolio requirements. The amendment also requires that a generator fueled by municipal solid waste in conjunction with recycling that may be selected for a contract for energy and renewable energy credits in accordance with the bill must be licensed in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 1310-N, which provides that a license from the Department of Environmental
