COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 724, L.D. 1105, “An Act Concerning Displaced Civilian Federal Firefighters in Maine”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1407 in the first indented paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "shipyard," the following: 'a'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment removes the provision of the bill that requires municipalities, when filling an open position for a firefighter, to give priority consideration to civilian federal firefighters who have been displaced due to a reduction in force at or closure of a federal military installation. It retains the provision of the bill that requires the Department of Labor to establish and maintain a database of displaced civilian federal firefighters in Maine.
