2	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the bill.
3	The amendment repeals unallocated language in Public Law 2011, chapter 380, Part UU
4	that had set the child care subsidy reimbursement rates at the 50th percentile of local
5	market rates. This amendment increases the reimbursement rates to the 60th percentile of
6	local market rates beginning on August 1, 2016, the implementation date for the new
7	child care and development fund plan for Maine.
