Amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides ongoing funds for a subscription to a filtering technology necessary to prevent the State's prekindergarten to grade 12 students and public library users from sending, receiving, viewing or downloading materials that are child pornography or obscene matter or that depict sexual exploitation of a minor through the Maine School and Library Network.
