COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 950, L.D. 1315, Bill, “An Act To Support Medically Monitored Crisis Support and Intervention”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §3174-BBB by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 1, lines 5 to 12 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'1. Reimbursement. By December 31, 2019, the department shall establish a rate under the MaineCare program that is sufficient to provide medically monitored crisis support and intervention to a person 18 years of age or older with mental health and co-occurring substance use disorders who seeks treatment voluntarily. Medically monitored crisis support and intervention includes, but is not limited to: psychiatric medical evaluation; psychiatric stabilization; substance detoxification; 24-hour nursing care; medication stabilization, monitoring, administration and education; and individual, group and family counseling.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that the Department of Health and Human Services must establish a rate under the MaineCare program that is sufficient to provide medically monitored crisis support and intervention to an adult. The rate must be established in rule by December 31, 2019.
