COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1014, L.D. 1399, Bill, “An Act To Improve Oral Health and Access to Dental Care for Maine Children”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

**Sec. 1. Report on preventive oral health services.** The Department of Health and Human Services shall report on the status of the preventive oral health services provided in schools through the Department of Health and Human Services, Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, rural health and primary care division's oral health program, including the number of schools and children served and the results of those services, which populations and geographic areas are not being covered by the services provided by the program and whether additional funding is needed. The department shall submit a report, including recommendations for funding or improvements to the program, no later than December 15, 2020 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over oral health matters, which may report out legislation to the First Regular Session of the 130th Legislature based on the report.
