COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1066, L.D. 1450, “An Act To Provide Fairness in Communications from Pharmacy Benefits Managers”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4348-A is enacted to read:

§4348-A. Use of untrue, deceptive or misleading advertisement prohibited

A pharmacy benefits manager or representative of a pharmacy benefits manager may not cause or knowingly permit the use of any advertisement, promotion, solicitation, representation, proposal or offer that is untrue, deceptive or misleading.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It prohibits a pharmacy benefits manager or representative of a pharmacy benefits manager from causing or knowingly permitting the use of any advertisement, promotion, solicitation, representation, proposal or offer that is untrue, deceptive or misleading.
