COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1077, L.D. 1623, “An Act to Amend Certain Fish and Wildlife Laws Related to Landowner Representation Regarding Abandoned Property”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (5) in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", after consultation with the Bureau of Warden Service,"

Amend the bill in section 8 in §2001 in subsection 3 in the 7th and 8th lines (page 3, lines 41 and 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", after consultation with the Bureau of Warden Service,"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language from the bill that requires a landowner or a landowner's representative to consult with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Bureau of Warden Service before taking ownership of an abandoned ladder, observation stand, camera or electronic surveillance equipment.
