## **SUMMARY** 1 2 This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, adds persons who have received an associate degree or a credential to those who are potentially eligible for the 3 Maine Credentialed Workforce Program established in the bill and clarifies that to be 4 eligible for the program an applicant must have outstanding student loan debt or eligible 5 6 student loans.
