COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1103, L.D. 1662, “An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Zoning and Land Use Restrictions to Limit Certain Requirements to Municipalities with Populations of More than 10,000”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Amend the Laws Regarding Zoning and Land Use Restrictions to Limit Certain Requirements to Municipalities with Populations of More than 4,000'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10,000" and inserting the following: '4,000'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10,000" and inserting the following: '4,000'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1-C in the last line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10,000" and inserting the following: '4,000'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the population thresholds provided in the bill so that they apply to municipalities with a population of more than 4,000. The amendment also removes an unnecessary provision in the bill.
