COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1112, L.D. 1677, “An Act to Establish the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias Prevention and Support Program”

Amend the bill in section 2 in c. 279 in §1700-G in the indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "department." the following: 'The department shall implement the requirements of this section to the extent possible given available resources and shall develop its budget for the program to include state matching funds for federal funds, regardless of whether federal funding is received. The department may seek and receive private grant funds to support the program.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

It provides that the department may seek and receive private grant funds to support the program. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
