COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1196, L.D. 1716, Bill, “An Act To Protect Persons Who Provide Assistance to Law Enforcement Dogs, Search and Rescue Dogs and Service Dogs”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §164-B in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 1, lines 7 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'A. "Emergency medical services person" has the same meaning as "emergency medical services' person" in Title 32, section 83, subsection 12.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill's definition of "emergency medical services person" with a definition cross-referencing the existing definition of "emergency medical services' person" in the Maine Emergency Medical Services Act of 1982.
