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## **SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, moves the start date for salary supplements for providers of child care and early childhood educators working with children up to 5 years of age to January 1, 2024 and shifts the funding associated with that initiative to also begin in fiscal year 2023-24. A section is added providing for the future funding of the salary supplements by directing the Commissioner of Health and Human Services to provide, as part of the Department of Health and Human Services budget estimate for fiscal year 2023-24, ongoing appropriations of \$4,500,000 from the
