15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "amounts" the following: ", with each fund or
program fully funded before funds are directed to the next priority fund or program."

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 7 in paragraph C by striking out all of
subparagraphs (1) and (2) (page 1, lines 16 to 23 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 7 in paragraph C by renumbering the
subparagraphs to read consecutively.

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
allocations are made.

7 removes the exemption from property tax for agricultural buildings as proposed in the bill.
