COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1254, L.D. 1808, Bill, “An Act To Implement Recommendations Resulting from a State Government Evaluation Act Review of the Department of Environmental Protection by the Joint Standing Committee on Environment and Natural Resources”

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 (page 2, lines 6 to 44 and page 3, lines 1 to 6 in L.D.).

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes from the bill the provision that clarifies 2 statutory exemptions from the requirement that air contamination sources maintain continuous emission monitoring systems to mitigate a conflict between the current statutory provisions on continuous emission monitoring and existing applicable federal regulations.
