COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1281, L.D. 1920, “An Act to Prohibit the Sale of Potentially Intoxicating Hemp Products to a Person Under 21 Years of Age”

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 13 in paragraph A in the first line (page 2, line 29 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "a" the following: 'beverage.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, adds beverages to the list of potentially intoxicating hemp products that are not required to be packaged in child-resistant and tamper-evident packaging.
