Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2510, sub-§2-A,** as enacted by PL 1997, c. 680, Pt. D, §4, is amended to read:

**2-A. Confidentiality of letters of guidance or concern.** Letters of guidance or concern issued by the board pursuant to Title 10, section 8003, subsection 5, paragraph E, or Title 32, section 18325, subsection 3 are not confidential.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24, section 2510, subsection 2-A includes a cross-reference to Title 10, section 8003, subsection 5, paragraph E, which previously governed the authority for the Board of Dental Practice to issue letters of guidance. This amendment adds a cross-reference to the provision of the bill that grants statutory authority of the Board of Dental Practice to issue letters of guidance.
