COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1319, L.D. 2057, “An Act to Require the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists and the Board of Examiners in Physical Therapy to Obtain Fingerprint-based Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Background Checks for Applicants for Licensure”

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph BB in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "therapy" and inserting the following: 'therapist'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

**'Sec. 6. 32 MRSA §3121**, as enacted by PL 2023, c. 317, §10, is repealed.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment makes a technical correction by changing "physical therapy assistant" to "physical therapist assistant" and removes a provision in current law made redundant by the enactment of the provision in the bill requiring the Board of Examiners in Physical Therapy to obtain national and state fingerprint-based criminal history record information for applicants for initial licensure and licensure by endorsement.
