COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1478, L.D. 1992, “An Act Related to the Electronic Registration and Tagging of Turkey”

Amend the bill in section 7 in §12307 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or 2023"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 8 the following:

**'Sec. 9. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**INLAND FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE, DEPARTMENT OF  
Enforcement Operations - Inland Fisheries and Wildlife 0537**

Initiative: Provides one-time funding for the capture and banding of turkeys and for a hunter survey to prevent loss of important wildlife management information with the implementation of electronic registration and tagging of turkey.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment limits to the year 2022 the exception to the requirement to register or attach a tag to a turkey killed during the fall open season.
