The fiscal note states that, to the extent that the collection of impact fees requires a 27 local unit of government to expand or modify its activities so as to necessitate additional 28 expenditures from local revenue, expenditure of local revenue may be required, and, as a 29 result, the fiscal note flags the legislation as a potential mandate. The committee reviewed 30 the fiscal note, and the minority of the committee determined that the requirements of the 31 legislation do not amount to a mandate. Many municipalities already collect docking fees 32 or other fees, and so the legislation does not require them to add new infrastructure to 33 collect the impact fees. In addition, 50% of the impact fee is proposed to be distributed to 34 municipalities to support harbor and sea level rise mitigation infrastructure and 50% to

1	support public transit infrastructure, and this can be used to offset any cost to municipalities
2	of implementing the impact fees. As such, the minority of the committee believes that this
3	requirement does not mandate a municipality to do anything it cannot already do within
4	existing resources.
5	This amendment provides baseline allocations to establish the Megayacht Fund.
