27 28	A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.
29 30 31	B. A person who violates this subsection after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class E crime.'

33 34	This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. It provides that a passenger under 14 years of age who is properly secured in a seat belt and riding directly adjacent to
