15 16 17 18	This amendment adjusts the ongoing transfer to the Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund, established in the bill, from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund from \$266,000 annually to \$410,000 biennially. It also limits the unexpended balance in the new fund to \$1,500,000.
19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	The amendment provides that the biennial transfer of funds from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the new fund and the transfer of funds as a result of carrying forward and transferring any remaining balances in the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Corporations, Elections and Commissions program, General Fund account at the end of each fiscal year must be reduced by any amount that would create an unexpended balance in excess of \$1,500,000. It also provides that by June 30th of each fiscal year, the State Controller must transfer from the new fund to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund any amount in excess of \$1,500,000.
