**Sec. 1. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund \$100,000 no later than June 30, 2018 and \$100,000 no later than June 30, 2019 from the Medical Use of Marijuana Fund, established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 2430.
