The director shall collect for deposit to the General Fund 10% 20 of gross fantasy contest revenues, including any revenues earned while operating pending 21 approval of an application submitted to the director as described in section 1103, subsection 22 9, from a fantasy contest operator licensed under this chapter that has gross fantasy contest 23 revenues of \$100,000 or greater.' 24 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 25 number to read consecutively. **SUMMARY** 26 27 This amendment replaces the bill. It updates the definition of "fantasy contest" to mean 28 a game or contest in which 2 or more contestants, none of which may be the fantasy contest 29 operator, pay an entry fee to participate. The amendment removes the definition of 30 "proposition bet" from the bill and the prohibition on fantasy contests based on proposition 31 betting. The amendment removes from the bill changes to the initial and renewal fee for a 32 license for a fantasy contest operator and removes the repeal of the provision of law 33 allowing a fantasy contest operator to operate a fantasy contest while an initial license, 34 license renewal or license transfer is pending. The amendment also provides that the
