COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 65, L.D. 219, Bill, “An Act To Prioritize Use of Available Resources in General Assistance Programs”

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §4308, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 489, §§5 and 14, is amended to read:

A. A person who is currently disqualified from general assistance for a violation of section 4315, 4316-A ~~or~~ 4317 or 4317-A is ineligible for emergency assistance under this subsection.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, adds a cross-reference to provide that a person who is disqualified from general assistance for a violation of the provisions of the bill is ineligible for emergency general assistance.
