COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 108, L.D. 294, Bill, “An Act To Allow a Home Heating Oil Delivery Driver To Bleed a Home Heating Oil Burner”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §18134-A in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "**of**" the following: "**a residential home**"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §18134-A in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "home heating oil burner without direct supervision" and inserting the following: 'residential home heating oil burner without direct supervision if the delivery driver has documentation of having completed a board-approved training course in bleeding oil burners'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It provides that a home heating oil delivery driver may bleed a residential home heating oil burner without direct supervision if the driver has documentation of completion of a training course in bleeding oil burners approved by the Maine Fuel Board.
