COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 270, L.D. 587, “An Act to Require Cardiac Emergency Response Plans and Athletic Emergency Action Plans for Schools and School-sponsored Athletic Events”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Require School Boards to Adopt a Policy on Automated External Defibrillator Access at School Events'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6304-A is enacted to read:

§6304-A. Policy for access to automated external defibrillators

Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, a school administrative unit shall develop and implement a policy that provides access to automated external defibrillators at all school-sponsored events. The policy must include how a person can access an automated external defibrillator while attending a school-sponsored event.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. The amendment requires school administrative units to develop and implement a policy that provides access to automated external defibrillators at all school-sponsored events. The policy must include how a person can access an automated external defibrillator while attending a school-sponsored event.
